Gastroenterology: Treating Disorders That Account for Workplace Absenteeism

Approximately 70 million people are affected by a digestive disease or disorder, with indirect and direct medical costs totaling \$107 billion each year. A gastroenterologist is the physician specialist that will treat patients with conditions in this area of the body. Problems with the gastrointestinal (GI) track can affect; the esophagus, stomach, small intestine, and large intestine (colon and rectum). These disorders can range from an irritated stomach to colorectal cancer. Gastroenterologists are trained to treat conditions involving the GI track, as well as the pancreas, gallbladder and liver.

Gastrointestinal disorders also account for one the most common reasons for workplace absenteeism. This is why the successful treatment of these disorders can save millions of dollars to employers each year. In order for a gastroenterologist to reach a diagnosis, the physician must take a physical examination of the patient and obtain the patient's medical history. If a condition requires further diagnostic testing, the physician can order lab tests, imaging and/or endoscopic procedures. Also, since alcohol abuse is the greatest risk factor for a digestive disease, it is important for the gastroenterologist to promote the benefits of a healthy lifestyle.

But what does it take to be a gastroenterologist? The minimum educational requirement for entry into a medical school is three years of college, but most applicants have at least a bachelor's degree. There are 146 medical schools in the United States, and they require applicants to submit school transcripts, scores from the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) and letters of recommendation. Students spend most of the first two years of medical school in laboratories and classrooms, and the last two years working with patients in hospitals and clinics under the supervision of experienced physicians. They gain experience in several areas through rotations or by spending concentrated time in specialties such as internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, psychiatry and surgery.

Following four years of medical school and three years in an internal medicine residency program, gastroenterologists enter a medical fellowship program that lasts three years during which the fellow is working at the hospital or clinic seeing patients under the watchful eye of supervising physicians. There are 155 accredited gastroenterology fellowship programs in the United States.

Nationally there are approximately 1,087 active gastroenterology fellows. Approximately 76 percent of the gastroenterology fellows nationally are male and 24 percent are female.

The University of Cincinnati offers a three-year accredited residency program for internal medicine, and a three-year accredited fellowship program for gastroenterology. Residents and fellows are paid and provided benefits. The pay ranges from \$41,000 to \$49,000, depending on their year of training. There are fifteen to eighteen internal medicine residency slots, and two to four gastroenterology fellowship slots each year at the University of Cincinnati.
